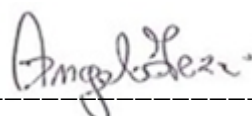

CROATIA

- Croatia, officially the Republic of Croatia (Croatian: Republika Hrvatska), is a country at the crossroads of Central and Southeast Europe. It shares a coastline along the Adriatic Sea. It borders Slovenia to the northwest, Hungary to the northeast, Serbia to the east, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Montenegro to the southeast, and shares a maritime border with Italy to the west and southwest. Croatia's capital and largest city, Zagreb, forms one of the country's primary subdivisions, with twenty counties. Croatia is a republic governed under a parliamentary system. It is a member of the European Union, NATO, the United Nations, the Council of Europe, the World Trade Organization, and a founding member of the Union for the Mediterranean.



GENERAL INFO

- ▶ **CURRENCY:** EURO is the official currency from 1 January 2023 as Croatia officially became the 20th Eurozone member
- ▶ **CAPITAL CITY:** ZAGREB
- ▶ **HOSTING CITY OF CUP OF EUROPE:** PULA
- ▶ **NEAREST AIRPORT:** PULA
- ▶ **WEATHER:** The average maximum daytime temperature in Pula in November lies at 12.8°C. The average minimum temperature goes down to around 5.7°C (often the minimum temperature is noted at night)
- ▶ **TRAVELING:** Travel to and from Croatia is easier from January 1 2023, when Croatia officially became part of the single Schengen area.

CAPITAL CITY- ZAGREB

- The city of Zagreb, capital of Croatia, on the historic and political threshold between East and West, illustrates both the continental and Mediterranean spirit of the nation it spearheads. Zagreb is the cultural, scientific, economic, political and administrative center of the Republic of Croatia, and is home to the Croatian Parliament, Government and President. Its favorable location between the Pannonian plain, the edge of the Alps and the Dinaric range has allowed it to become a crossing point for mass international communication. The population of the city in 2021 was 769,944. The population of the Zagreb urban agglomeration is 1.071.150, approximately a quarter of the total population of Croatia.



HOSTING CITY OF CUP OF EUROPE- PULA

Pula is the largest city in Istria County, Croatia, and the seventh-largest city in the country, situated at the southern tip of the Istrian peninsula in northwestern Croatia, with a population of 52,220 in 2021. It is known for its multitude of ancient Roman buildings, the most famous of which is the Pula Arena, one of the best preserved Roman amphitheaters. The city has a long tradition of wine making, fishing, shipbuilding, and tourism.

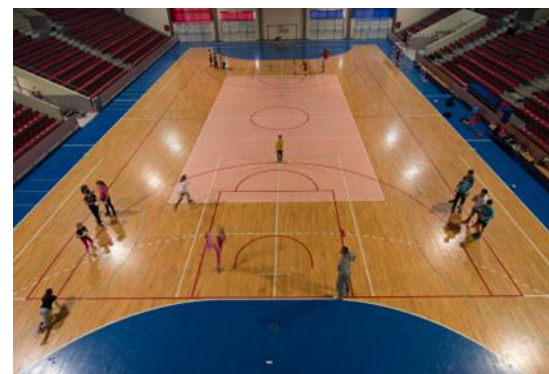
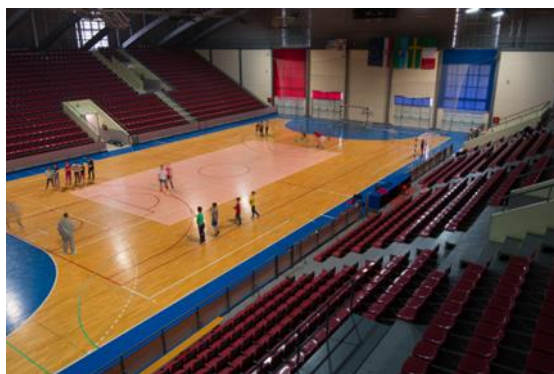
OTHER AIRPORTS CLOSE TO PULA:

- ▶ **ZAGREB AIRPORT** - cca 270 km distance. You can reach Pula by transfer (cca 3,0 hours driving) or by daily flight, operated by Croatian Airlines, flight is cca 40 min.
- ▶ **TRIESTE AIRPORT** - cca 140 km distance. You can reach Pula by transfer (cca 1,5 hours driving). It is connected all the way with the highway.
- ▶ **VENICE AIRPORT** - cca 290 distance. You can reach Pula by transfer (cca 3,0 hours driving). It is connected all the way with the highway.

RINK OF CUP OF EUROPE 2023

- The Mate Parlov Sport Centre (Dom sportova Mate Parlov, Street: Galijotska ul., 52100 Pula, Croatia) is a multi-purpose indoor sports arena located in Pula, Croatia. Currently the arena has a capacity of 2,312 seats.

Other Distance from the RINK:

- ▶ City center and historic center of Pula - 3km, 5 min by car, 20 min walking distance
- ▶ Shopping Center “Max city Pula” - 800m, 1 min by car, 7 min walking
- ▶ City swimming pool - 20 m from the rink
- ▶ Beaches “Lungomare” - 1 km, 3 min by car, 10 min walking distance
