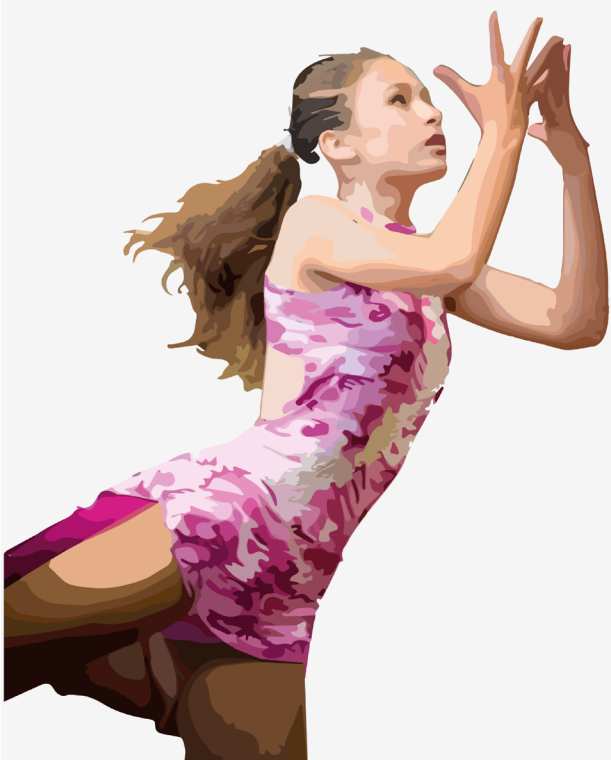

Panel composed by international Judges, Specialists and Data Operators, invited by World Skate and Portuguese Skating Federation.



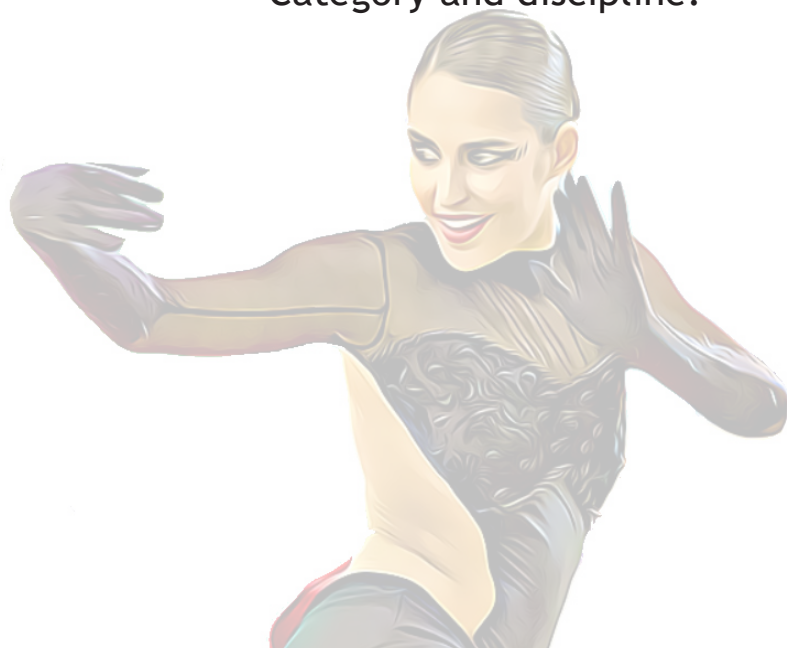
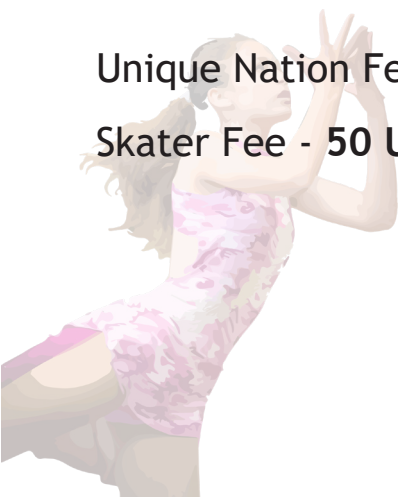
Entries

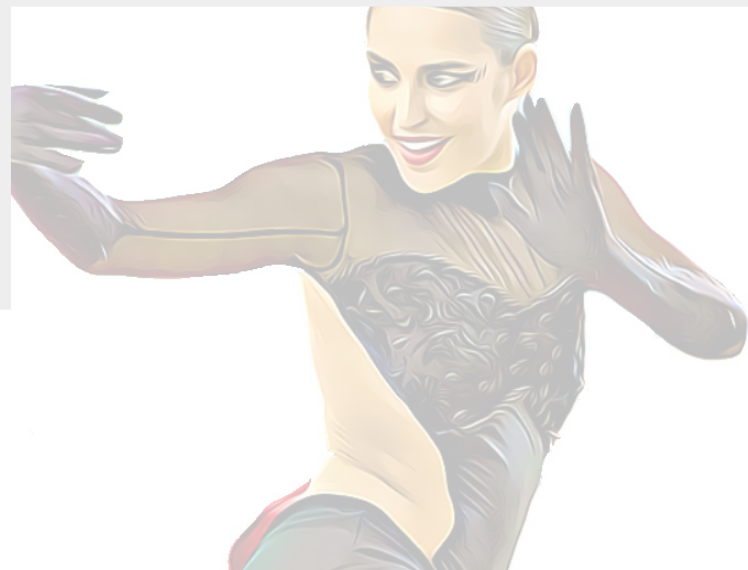


Sines City
