

IMPORTANT INFORMATION AMMENDMENTS TO WORLD SKATE DOCUMENTS 2025

General 2025

- 2.20 Costume Requirements - Precision
Any piece of the costume must be very **securely stitched** so as not to cause obstruction to the following contestants.

Freeskating 2025

- Long Program Espoir
Maximum two (2) spin elements are allowed. One of them must be a combination spin and must include a sit spin. Combination spins can have a maximum four (4) positions. The same kind of spin cannot be performed more than twice in the whole program (i.e. maximum two inverted, maximum two forward heel etc.). Broken is not allowed and the two spins must be different.
- Footwork Sequence
Requirement to cover $\frac{3}{4}$ of the skating surface has been removed.

Pairs 2025

- Side by Side Jumps
If the number of rotations is different for the two partners (e.g. man executes a double axel and the lady an axel) **the jump will be given no value**. The technical panel will call the jump with less value **and star it out**.
- Side by Side Spins
If the skaters execute different spins (e.g. the man a heel spin and the lady just a camel), **the spin will be given no value**. The technical panel will call the spin with less value **and star it out**.
- Footwork Sequence
Requirement to cover $\frac{3}{4}$ of the skating surface has been removed.
- Combination Contact Spins
For Junior and Senior Short Program and Junior and Senior Long Program.
Maximum three (3) positions.

Dance & Solo Dance Book 2025

- 2.5 Style Dance Rhythms
Note: If a time period is specified music MUST be of the period indicated. Remastered copies are permitted.
- 2.6 Rhythm Descriptions
Section added (see Dance Book)

Solo Dance 2025

- Choreographic Stop
Description amended to remove reference to style dance.

Dance 2025

- Choreographic Stop
Description amended to remove reference to style dance.

Quartets 2025

- 1.7 Synchronized Cluster Sequences
The time limit has been removed. This applies also to the cluster in the Combo element.

Inline 2025

- 3.2 Short Program
Short Programs combo spins can have a maximum of **four (4)** positions.
- 3.3 Long Program
Long Programs of Espoir, Cadet, Youth, Junior and Senior combo spins can have a maximum of **four (4)** positions.
- 4.1 Jumps
Junior and Senior, one rotation jumps placed on the first or last position of the combination jump will be called, given NO VALUE and count toward the total number of jumps allowed.
- 4.2 Spins
Solo Spin: **Minimum three (3)** continuous rotations in the position already reached to be called.



ALL difficult positions are only allowed once per program. If presented a second time the basic position (camel, sit, upright, broken, inverted, heel) will be starred out and given NO value.

- 5.2 Negative QOE
QOE additions (see table of errors).
