# Information Bulletin no. 1

The Dutch Federation for Rollersports (NRB) is hosting the European Championships for Show and Precision 2020 in Almere, the Netherlands. We thank World Skate Europe for this great opportunity.

# A. Date and Venue

The Championships will take place on the  $1^{st}$  and  $2^{nd}$  of May 2020, official training starts on the  $30^{th}$  of April 2020. The event will take place in Almere.

Almere is the youngest and most innovative city in the Netherlands. From the moment of its establishment in 1976, Almere has been one of the fastest growing cities in Europe. Almere is a city raised from the sea. Almere lies 3 to 5 meters below sea level.

The venue is easy to reach by car or by public transportation. The venue is next to the railway and bus station Almere Poort, with a direct connection to Amsterdam Central Station (only 25 minutes). The venue is also perfectly accessible by car (next to highway A6) and has a large free parking facility for both cars and busses. The connection between the venue and Schiphol international airport is great: 25/30 minutes by car or 35/40 minutes by train.

The floor is a floating wooden floor, type multilastic triathlon KH. The surface area is at least 45 x 25 meters.

Recommended wheels: 90A / 92A

On Wednesday, Thursday and Friday it is possible to book extra training sessions (with a similar floor) in the Topsportcentrum and a rink within 10 kilometers distance – see information on the website

#### Photos from all skaters and officials

We kindly ask all participating Clubs to send low resolution passport photos in **JPEG** format for **ALL** people to be accredited (skaters, trainers, choreographers, delegates, etc). Please send all the photos from one Club together in one e-mail before **31**<sup>st</sup> of **March 2020**.

The aspect ratio of the photo must be 2:3 (preferably 32x48mm). Please do not send the photos in pdf or Word files. It would be very useful for us if you could save each photo (individually) as follows "Last name\_first name.jpg". Example: Smith\_John.jpg. Please make sure the names are exactly the same as the names on the subscription form.

Free entrance will be granted to each Club following the rules written in WSE Artistic Rules Book:

- 1 delegate per Club
- 1 trainer x EACH Group/Quartet/Precision Team (extra trainers can pay for a pass)
- 1 choreographer x EACH Group/Quartet/Precision Team (extra choreographer can pay for a pass)
- 1 extra Person for helping in dressing room each 10 skaters of the club (e.g. 30-35 skaters, will be given 3 extra passes; 36-40 skaters 4 extra passes)
- 2 bus drivers

#### Entry passes per Nation:

- 1 representative of a Federation
- 1 medical person (qualified)

Extra passes can be purchased at €36 per person for the whole event.

For Show teams: remember to send a short explanation about SHOW Categories – 25 WORDS MAX for describing each performance in **ENGLISH** 

For Precision teams: remember to fill in and send the Programme elements content sheet Precision 2020

Registration (Passport-ID Card control) & Payments of ALL Clubs: for a quick check of the documents it is allowed to bring photocopies (complete!) of all skaters documents (passport or ID card where it is possible to see the citizenship) to leave for the WSE Committee.

### F. Tickets

From the 14<sup>th</sup> of February 2020 tickets can be purchased via the website (link to external ticket shop).

#### **Prices**

Adults € 21 per day – € 36 for 2 days

Children 4 - 12 years old € 12 per day – € 20 for 2 days

Children under 4 years old free

There will be no reserved seats.

You can also buy tickets at the box office on the days of competition.

#### G. Pictures and Video

It is possible to buy photos of the event at the official photo booth inside the sports centre. Using video cameras in only possible by obtaining a video accreditation. You can buy this accreditation in the sports centre at 30 euro per video camera.

The organizers will try to provide a live stream from all events. Check the website for an update on videos or live stream.

# H. Flags and banners

It is forbidden to place flags of the different countries or clubs. The organization will place the official flags of each participating country in visible places.

Banners are only allowed when they have maximum measures of 2.00 x 1.00m and when they are delivered to the organization before the start of the competition. The organization will place them in the reserved area.

Failure to comply with the rule will imply the immediate withdrawal of flags and banners.
