IMPORTANT AMENDMENT TO PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS FOR COUPLES DANCE AND PAIRS EVENTS 2025

In reference to the existing, World Skate Artistic General Rules 2.3: Categories for an International Championship, rule stating:

"For all World Skate Artistic International Series, Continental and World Skate Games or World Championships competitions there must be a minimum of three (3) skaters/teams participating and representation from at least two (2) different National Federations for an event to be contested. Exceptional situations that require an alternate way to manage the events will be taken into consideration by the World Skate Artistic Technical Commission."

Amendment for 2025 Season:

For the 2025 World Skate Artistic International Series and Continental Championship Competitions, the World Skate Artistic Technical Commission authorizes an exception to the above rule for the *Couples Dance* and *Pairs* disciplines.

In cases where the minimum participation requirements (three [3] teams and representation from two [2] National Federations) are not met, the event may proceed in a **non-medal exhibition format**.

- The event will be held and judged, and participating skaters/teams will receive a performance report (PDF).
- Results from these events will **not** be officially published.
- No World Skate Ranking points will be awarded.
- Skaters may receive a certificate of participation.
- For the International Series only, total scores from these exhibition-format events will still be considered for qualification to the World Skate Artistic Final.

National Federations will be informed immediately after close of entries if this applies to any of their nominated skaters.

This amendment applies exclusively to the 2025 competitive season and is subject to review for future years.
